- featured 115+ women leaders

### WISE 2025 programming

#### **Keynote Event**

A keynote event will be our premier program, targeted for Climate Week 2025. Our 2024 WISE Climate Week panel discussion entitled "Bridging the Gap Between Equity & Electrification" was our most popular event of the year, drawing in 134 in-person and virtual attendees.

#### **Industry Insights**

We will organize events, such as a Sustainable Career Showcase and Radio BE-Ex interviews, during which accomplished professionals will share insights into their career path and areas of expertise.

#### **Networking Opportunities**

We will host at least two networking events aimed at fostering community and connecting emerging, industry-transitioning, and established professionals across the sustainability and energy fields.

Our yearly celebration is an evening of camaraderie amongst BE-Ex & WISE community members, during which we commemorate our past accomplishments, look to our future goals, and raise a glass with friends.
